



JOIN A SKEET OR TRAP LEAUGE! **2014 SKEET RANGE IMPROVEMENTS:** Last year the membership approved purchasing 4 new skeet machines with turrets. This has been a GREAT IMPROVEMENT for our shooters and an excellent investment! If you haven't made it out to see the changes yourself, bring a friend & stop by!

YOUTH PROGRAM: Helping young shooters try out trap and skeet shooting at a low cost. Each person under 18 gets a youth card that is good for 5 rounds. The shooter pays for the round (\$2.50) and gets a free box of shells. Come on out!
