## SPRING 2017

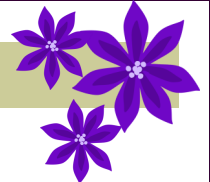
Spring is shaping up to be a busy time at the club!



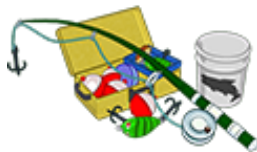
We will see the return of the Sunday Calcuttas and Friday night shoots starting in April, along with the area's best pancake breakfast!
